Letter From the Publisher by Jim Furey





Most of us are sport fans of one type or another, whether it is motorcycle racing, NASCAR, baseball, football or hockey; however, very few of us follow these pursuits with the passion of Steve Strain. His passion has earned him and his bike an article in this month's magazine.

Steve and I have been working on getting together since last year's Wide Open Bike Show in Wentzville where his bike was on display at the Gateway Thunder booth. And with good reason—this bike began its incarnation as a 2005 Big Dog Ridgeback. As such it features a 117 cubic inch polished S&S engine, Big Dog balanced drive system, a Baker 6-speed transmission, Mean Mother exhaust, right side belt drive, 300mm rear tire, 40 degree rake, hidden oil tank and an LED tach. The folks at Gateway Thunder Big Dog led by owner Greg and his staff of Tommy, Tim, Brian, Josh, Ryan & Kim are acknowledged on Steve's website for their help with the bike.

Paint like this is done by only one shop in this area, Liquid Illusions. Darren Williams of Liquid Illusions is a very talented artist that takes your ideas and breathes life into them. This bike is just another example of the awesome work that he and Radical Randy do.

While this bike belongs to Steve, we would be remiss if we didn't acknowledge his wife, Carol, who shares his love of the Blues. In fact their license plates were featured in the

Blues 2002 "Do you bleed Blue?" billboards, and that same year Steve was one of the 10 finalists in the Blues Seventh Man contest. In fact not only does this bike have a Blues theme, but so does his whole garage.

The laser tattooing on the bike was done by MarkKings and provides some excellent highlights. Carol wanted some





sparkle to the bike to help celebrate their 30th anniversary, so Steve always the gentleman, had the cylinders and heads diamond cut by Diamond Heads. The finishing touch on this very sharp ride was the custom seat created by High End Seats. Killer and Joyce's Rocky Mountain Adventure by Killer Miller

Part Two: Into (and Out Of) Dodge

"...and starring James Arness as Marshal Matt Dillon." For most of you this doesn't mean anything, but readers of my generation know this as the sign on for *Gunsmoke*, the TV Western that took place in the cattle town of Dodge City, Kansas. This town was first on Joyce and my list of things to see on the Rocky Mountain trip, and we arrived there after one and a half days on the road.

Marshal Dillon was fictional, but the real characters who lived here are just as legendary: names like Wyatt Earp, Doc Holliday, and Bat Masterson all ring in the legends of the Old West. Dodge City keeps these legends alive on its front street, where we met the current marshal (one of the last active mounted U.S. marshals), Charlie Meade. He has been either a marshal or deputy since the 1960s and really looks the part. Of course, what would a visit to Dodge City be without a trip to Miss Kitty's Long Branch, and yes, I had a beer (I did, too: a root beer—*Joyce*). After taking in some shows, we visited where the Real West was buried: the Boot Hill cemetery. Later, we took the tour and felt what a buffalo stampede would have felt like and heard the

talking bull (and that's no bull, folks).

By then, the day was waning and it was time to move, as more of Kansas loomed ahead. We stopped in Pratt, Kansas (home of the *Pratt* in Pratt and Whitney plane engines of WWII fame), to visit the world's deepest hand-dug well: 120 feet deep and 30 feet across. It was dug in 1887-1888 at the cost of \$45,000, and like so many other things in Kansas, it reminded us of *The Wizard of Oz*. As we crossed from Kansas into Colorado, we met Jim, a Tribe of Judah member on his way to meet his wife in Denver on his 1984 Lowrider. It's always nice to talk to other riders and hear their stories.

For those readers who don't know, the Rockies don't start right when you get into Colorado. For the most part, the first day of Colorado riding looked just like Kansas, except the color of the asphalt on Route 50 changes, as does the color of the cop cars. After getting a room in Lamar, we had dinner at a restaurant attached to the gas station. They had good food, which surprised me because road food usually goes one of three ways:

1. Good
2. Fair or indifferent, and
3. Oh my God, what is this crap?!

The next morning we gassed up, ate up, and rolling we went though Lamar (there is a famous Detroit Tigers pitcher from here, but I can't remember who) and La Junta before taking the turn toward Pueblo. This was the first large city we rode though. It's the gateway to the Rockies—you can really start to see the mountains' outline from here and you know you are getting close.

Pueblo would prove time-consuming, as a 10-minute gas stop took over an hour and a half as Joyce and I had our first on-the-road accident, and we weren't even on the bike. Instead, the bike got run into and knocked down on the parking lot while we were inside the mini mart. The poor kid who hit it probably thought I was going to kill him (as did I—*Joyce*) as a string of words not fit to print came out of me. But geez, it *was* a brand-new, unscarred bike there laying on the ground. After I convinced him that it would be in his best interest to help me get it on its tires again (thank God for the crash bars), we exchanged paperwork and calmed down.

It was after this that Joyce and I decided we were tired of cramming stuff into the bags. A trip to the Rockies—even in the summer—demands both summer and fall clothing, so we went off to find a tank bag (yes, they're goofy-looking, but they work). My son has my original that I bought on our honeymoon in Nashville. We found such a bag at the country's sixth-oldest Honda dealership, Timme Honda in Pueblo, Colorado. In addition, they had a really cool museum featuring old Indians that AMA Hall of Famer (and one of the founders of the Sturgis Rally) Walter Timme started. The museum's exhibits included a 1915 Powerplus, bikes from the 1920s (including a 101 Scout), a lineup of all the important Hondas, a Vincent Rapide, and a BSA Gold Star. It is so cool to stumble on stuff like this on a trip, and my thanks go out to the manager for letting us look around.

Well loaded up with the new tank bag (thanks, Joyce), we motored ever higher on roads and scenery that we will visit in Part Three as Joyce, I, and the big TC motor our way to the 2-Mile-High Club. Next time, Killer.






