I have often passed by the Cahokia Creek Riders facility near White City, Illinois, and recently saw there was to be a hill climb on August 4th. I contacted Mica who is involved with the Cahokia Creek Riders to ask if we could attend. He graciously said they would love to have us there so we made arrangements with several friends, including Tony Miller, to meet at the hill climb.

I have been by this hill many times and I often wondered how anyone could ride a motorcycle up it! I saw on this evening that many folks have no problem at all getting up and over the top. We saw riders of all ages attacking the hill, in fact, the riders ranged in age from 3 on up. Gates opened in the late afternoon and practice commenced; the riders ran their trials and made adjustments. These were not your usual bikes right off the street running up the hill, although there was an opportunity for that later. Rather, these are specially modified bikes with exaggerated swing arms.



Watching the races I noticed how the riders worked to find just the right place to start their runs. This leads me to

believe that the start is all important here which makes sense because there is very little time to make it up that hill. The times to get up to the top were incredibly fast, just a few seconds! I hadn't been to a hill climb in person ever although I had seen them on TV. Television just does not compare to seeing it in person. This was one of the most exciting evenings I have spent in a long time and the climb was thoroughly engaging.

I have really come to enjoy the events at places like this and BET. Both run AMA events so they are regulated, and it is by attending them that one gets an opportunity to see the young racers of tomorrow. 

Okay, as everyone knows old Killer here rides a lot. Still, I usually only attend one or two BIG bike events a year. Generally I'd much rather attend a small (fewer than 1000 people) event than an event with tens of thousands of attendees. So, although I had a good time at Little Sturgis, I'm still a little bit jaded about big events.

I'd never been to Hog Rock before, and it was also the CFMA's annual party and get-together. So, on the Friday after my anniversary (I love you, Mrs. Killer), Sidecar and I headed south on the two-lane to Cave-In Rock, Illinois, on the scenic Ohio River. We had a bit of a fracas in Anna, Illinois—the locals need to be a little more friendly (although the free beer did help make up for the hoosier attitude of the drunk)—but eventually we got to Hog Rock. The Illinois state police made sure we were all qualified to ride our beasts, then let us in. Hog Rock is HUGE, and if you don't know where your group is, it can take a while to find them. Bear that in mind if you go next year. It's also not a bad idea to get there on Thursday or even Wednesday to get set up.

Sidecar and I found our Brothers visiting and drinking and were soon being introduced to our foreign exchange riders Timo, Pasi, and Aino (she's the best looking of the three, mainly because she's the girl, and she was also one of the best-looking girls there, period). That's Aino on Batman's chopper. After that, I wandered around and saw the Wall of Death, or the American Motordome. These set-ups are super cool and are really hard to do because you're basically riding in a big barrel. They used to be all over in the 1920s and 1930s, but due to rider and spectator deaths there are now only three or four in the country. I talked to one of the riders (who was still using an old Indian Scout), and he told me that the trick is to look at the other side of the barrel or the gentle curve in

front of you but to never look at the floor until you start coming down off the wall. If you ever get a chance to see this, it is something else.

Friday and Saturday night featured all kinds of bands, including Sharp-Dressed Man (a great ZZ Top tribute group) and the Low-Cash Cowboys (a terrific high-energy country rock group). Of course, the lovely ladies were *everywhere*, showing what they got in not-so-subtle ways. The field events were super tough: the slow race was one of the best I've ever seen. The weenie bite was also fun, requiring a three-way bite-off to determine the winner. Of course, it's always great to visit—hello to Batman, Fuji, Redawg, Fuzzy Harold, Mex, Donnie, Rich, the girls, Sidecar, and all the rest of the CFMA group.



The ride home was hot but otherwise okay. I four-laned up the Missouri side after Cape Girardeau, but that's still cool (two lanes for trips, four lanes for getting home). All in all, I had a good time. Keep in mind: Hog Rock and events like it are cool but ADULT events. Don't go if you get offended easily. Still, make time for it next year—it's something you've got to see.—Killer






The Ride

He's decided that even though our paths have crossed, we now live in harmony with one another as he goes about his business of filling his belly. Besides, these days my breakfast has become a routine of warm coffee & a handful of pills. It's a shame what one little heart attack will do to change your lifestyle. But this is not my average morning. This ride has a purpose. That special little woman who is always on my mind is at the end of it. That's the one thing that has driven my life up to this point & has me eating those damn pills every morning. Oh well, I might as well get started. There's still a few hundred miles left in this journey and I'm not getting any closer just sitting here. I gather up some small branches and leaves and place them on the embers. Blowing gently I soon have my fire going again. I make my way down to the creek where I fill my canteen cup and place it gently on the fire. Spilling it now would just f**k my morning all to hell. As I wait for the water to warm up, I start packing the bike. Thoughts of her fill my mind once again. I remember how she felt in my arms. I still remember the sweet smell of her hair. There's a slight chill in the air, but the sun is warming me up nicely. It doesn't take long to feel that feeling of freedom as the wind blows around my face and hair.

All of a sudden, I feel a cold chill passing deep in my bones. It's gone as quickly as it came, but I know that feeling all too well. I've lost too many brothers in my lifetime along the way not to. It's the spirit of those who have gone before me. The ones who have lived and died by the words "Live to Ride. Ride to Live." I raise my hand in salute to their spirit as they pass. "Ride on man. Ride on."

With a little over a hundred miles under my belt this morning, I come across a small town in the middle of nowhere. I make out a tavern at the end of town with a sign that says "Food Served Here" so I think why not. It looks like it was right out of the old west but that isn't what caught my eye. It is the pair of black shovelheads pulled up to the hitching post out front. A horse is a horse, whether flesh or iron I think. "Now this is my kind of place," I say to myself as I walk through the double swinging doors.







opinion is a great thing. I hope in the future this ride gets big enough that the whole country hears about it and wants to go.



Double D's Anniversary by Jim Furey



A Memorial Mile by Jim Furey

Twice each year the Magical Mile at the Illinois State Fairgrounds in Springfield, IL, comes to life with the roar of Grand National Motorcycle Racing. While the main event is the Sportster Race, it is not just about Harley Davidsons.



On August 19th. I took part in the Belleville, Illinois HOG Chapter's poker run for the ELKS Crippled Children Fund. Joy and I arrived a little early which gave me an opportunity to receive a tour of the new dealership by the owner Virginia 'Jenny' Frieze. The building wasn't quite completed at the time, but the Grand Opening is scheduled for September 15th and by all accounts this will be an event you don't want to miss.

The first thing that caught my eye was the futuristic styling of the building's exterior. The second was the size; this is big!. As Jenny and I walked around to the front of the building, she pointed out where the entry plaza is going to be. It sounds awesome, incorporating an outdoor motorcycle display. As we walked around, Jenny explained to me the many facets of this structure that make it a green facility.

Among these were the light diffusers. These bring sunshine from outside and utilize fiber optics to deliver it inside the building. This provides light to the building and also a health benefit to the employees as this exposes them to real light. Frieze though has always provided a family friendly environment; there is always a playpen and children's area in their facilities.

The service area also plays a role in keeping the building green. Instead of the 55 gallon oil drums, they will utilize oil that comes in cardboard boxes with plastic bladders inside, much like those wine boxes I think. Then the oil will be pumped to the mechanics' benches so that it is right there when they are doing oil changes. The coolest part though is that the waste oil from these oil changes will be captured and then used to heat the building later.

In talking with Jenny, she told me the push to be greener was an extension of her home life where for years she has been an avid recycler. I applaud her for that and as I said to her if we don't do these things now then what will there be for our children and grandchildren? Hopefully forward thinking people such as her can make a difference and help other businesses see the value of being green.

All this said, you really owe it to yourself to go and check out their new shop. It is on Greenmount Road and just off I-64. I am sure the Grand Opening weekend will be one heckuva party and we hope to see you there!


